XII. NOTES

i. **Comments** The inscription is dated after the *grammateus*, something that point to a certain degree of internal organization.

XIII. EVALUATION

i. **Private association** Probable

Note The term *therapeutai* might simply stand for a group of worshippers. However, the dating of the inscription after the *grammateus* indicates some sort of internal structure in the group and thus a certain degree of durability.
